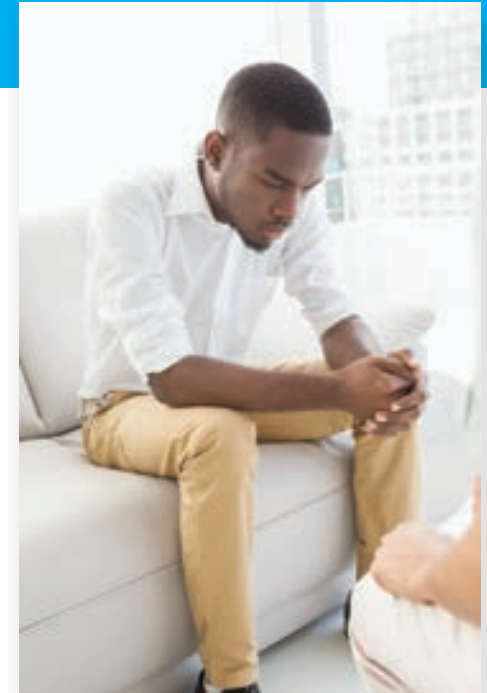

We provide crisis intervention and support to Union County residents age 18 and older who are experiencing a mental health crisis or a worsening of a pre-existing mental health disorder.

Our Crisis Intervention and Support Process

- Our multidisciplinary team assesses enrollees for their mental health needs and co-occurring needs if substance use is an issue.
- We provide clinical services and medication management as part of the brief crisis stabilization for all individuals.
- We partner with mental health outpatient centers and community agencies to ensure rapid referral and linkages take place, and that treatment continues after discharge if needed.

Our Services Include

- Crisis stabilization and de-escalation
- Comprehensive biopsychosocial assessment inclusive of risk assessment
- Individual therapy
- Treatment planning
- Illness management
- Group therapy
- Linkages and referrals for after-care
- Information and referrals for financial entitlements and housing/shelters
- Psychiatric evaluation for medication and medication management
- Bi-lingual Spanish staff and language line so those speaking any language can be seen for services

Our Team Is Here For You

- A team includes Licensed Clinicians, Psychiatric Advance Practice Nurses, a Wellness Specialist and a Psychiatrist.
- You are seen by a Licensed Clinician the same day you present for services. Psychiatric evaluations and medication are available when clinically indicated.
- The time period for services varies. For some, one or two visits are sufficient, while for others the maximum enrollment period of 30 days is beneficial. Services are all on-site.

We accept Medicaid, Medicare, and many third-party insurers. We also help those with no insurance. If needed, we provide assistance to pay for medications and arrange transportation.
