PESS will provide:

- Rapid mobile outreach focused on early intervention, least restrictive crisis intervention and hospital diversion
- A community based psychiatric emergency screening service center that features a Living Room model of care for the provision of crisis intervention services, planning, and follow-up appointments
- Use of flexible follow-up screening services, on-site and in-vivo, to ensure that individuals receive crisis intervention services while they are awaiting appointments with community providers. May include limited therapy sessions.
